

Here's a close up of one of the signs. It reads "Honor Wa-kan-ughzhubuh... Medicine Bottle - which I suppose is the name of one of the 39 unlucky Indians - Death by Hanging, etc."

Well Pinky the executions really did happen. But what people find offensive is that the signs only present one side of the story. The signs implicitly suggest that executing native people was part of a larger campaign to secure the land of this area for the commercial interests of the white settlers...
